2s → you! (singular)



mîcishkan

2p → you all! (plural)



mîcishkêk

2i → let us all! (plural)



mîcishkahk

2. Drop the last letter of this verb.
3. To the root verb add:
(2s) → NOTHING
(2p) → -k
(2i) → -tân





DELAYED IMPERATIVE MODE

1. Choose a verb, start with the "s/he does the action" form.
2. Drop the last letter of this verb.
3. To the root verb add:
(2s) → -hkan
(2p) → -hkêk
(2i) → -hkahk



Soften by using: mahti



Negate by using: êkâwiya
